Consulted on this 12-student team about game dev processes. Responsible for writing the project narrative, a fictional developer's "Day in the Life".
- *Outer Plates*: Sponsored by ITGM Dept. Chair to work on this senior project as a junior. Created & balanced the mid-game, level design, and mechanic & dynamic design. Won 5 Entelechy awads, including Best Level Design & Best in Show.
- Inflamed: With a theme of "Make Us Laugh", our 10-person team competed with 225+ SCAD students to create a playable game & trailer in just 48 hours. Responsible for concept & level design. 2024 Global Game Jam winner for the State of Georgia.
- Story Keepers: As a sophomore, lead SCADpro project commissioned by Stride. Developed an interactive experience for grades 8&9 for Stride's French Revolution curriculum. Managed & organized team of 20 and worked directly with design team throughout the project. Was the main point of communication with the Stride client.
- Game Devlopment Network (GDN) ITGM's Academic Club (100+ student members)
 - NoobJam 2024: Created & organized this campus-wide event, which targeted underclassmen to foster student involvement at SCAD and increase newcomers' confidence levels. Ten teams with 60+ students competed in the inaugural event, with over 20 upperclassman volunteers supporting the teams as mentors.
 - SCAD Day, 2022-Present: Represent SCAD & the ITGM Department at SCAD Day open houses (held each quarter) for prospective students & their familes. Conduct student tours & typically assigned as student resource for interactive family Q&A sessions.
 - Member, 2022-2023/Officer, 2023-2024/President, 2024-Present: Responsible for organizing and leading meetings and events (mixers, portfolio reviews, academic & professional workshops, etc.). Encourage cooperation and communication between all academic clubs to maximize student body participation and learning.
